Riverside Education Support Centre is pleased to provide feedback about the school's performance. The School Survey is a requirement of the Department of Education and is carried out every two years.

The information obtained is made available to the Department of Education, to the school community and is published on our website.

The results are satisfactory. The scores are high without exception across all areas covered. In addition, some respondents took the opportunity to add comments in support of their scoring.

The effectiveness of the survey was limited by the lower than usual participation rate. The completion period was extended three times, attracting a total of 13 participants, slightly more than half the number of respondents (24) of the previous survey in 2019.

Nevertheless, we accept the outcome as indicative of a school that strives to put student interests above all else, enjoys a strong relationship with the community, and supports staff to maintain the highest level of professionalism. In short, we continue to strive for improvement.

Parent Comment 4

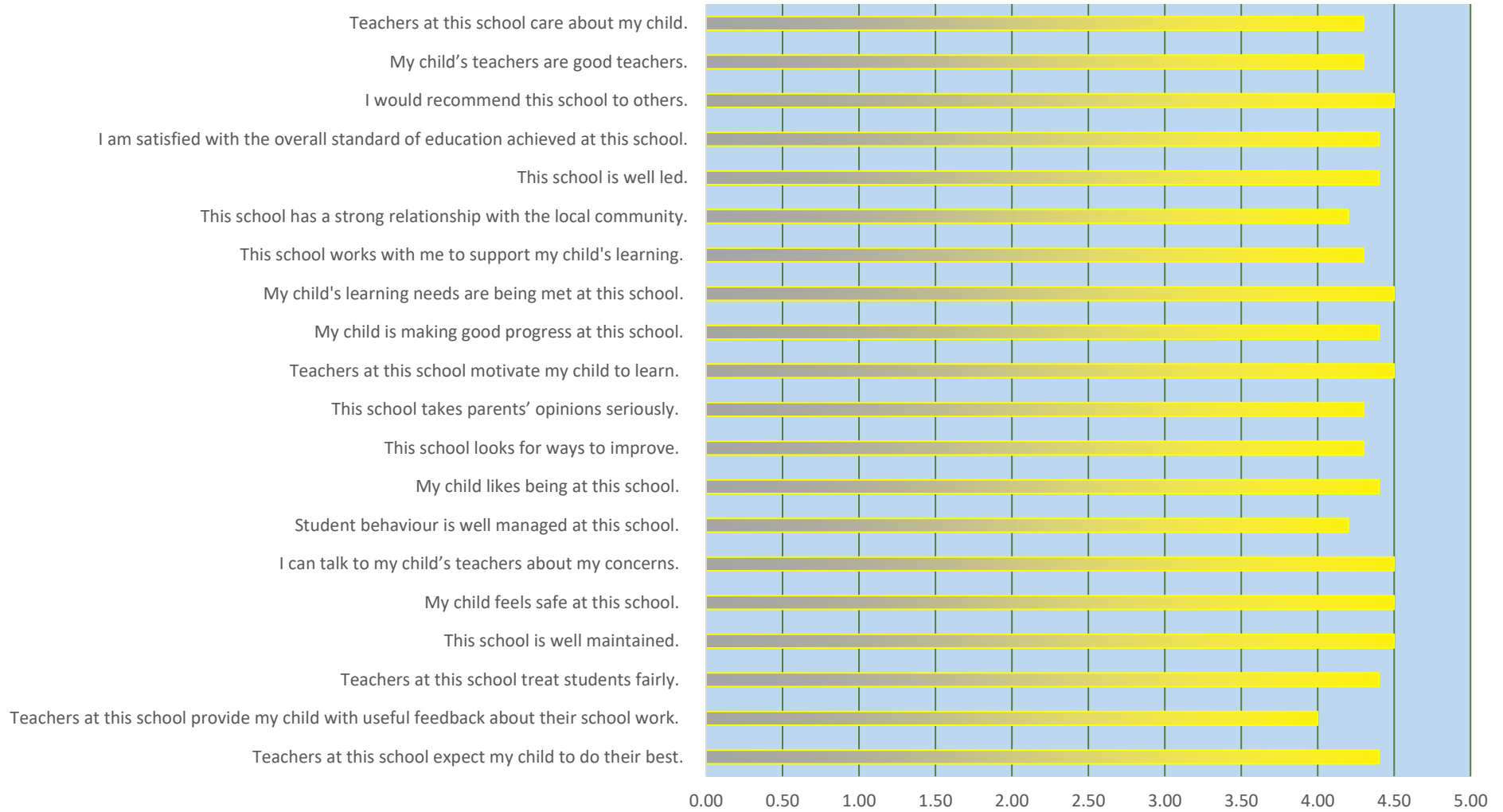
